



## 2010 Yerba Buena SkateBowl Camp

### **General Information:**

In order to give our campers more of our time and attention, our MAXIMUM number of campers in each session is now 20! As you can imagine, you will need to PLAN EARLY! Our camps are available for campers aged 6 through 14 (but in all honesty, they seem to be best suited for those aged 8-12)!

June 21 <sup>st</sup> – June 25 <sup>th</sup>
June 28 <sup>th</sup> – July 2 <sup>nd</sup>
* Special week for campers ages 6-9 only! July 5 <sup>th</sup> – July 9 <sup>th</sup>
July 26 <sup>th</sup> – July 30 <sup>th</sup>
August 2 <sup>nd</sup> – August 6 <sup>th</sup>
August 9 <sup>th</sup> – August 13 <sup>th</sup>

Each session will occur as long as a minimum of 10 campers are enrolled!

Camp hours are 9:00 am—5:00 pm, Monday through Friday of each camp week. You should plan to drop off your camper between 8:30 am and 9:00 am, and pick up your camper at the end of the day between 5:00 pm and 5:30 pm. (There may be some changes to this schedule for the Special “Single Digit Age” Camp week July 5<sup>th</sup> – July 9<sup>th</sup>!)

### **Registration Policies:**

A deposit of \$50 per session is required in order to register. Full balance for camp is due a minimum of 21 days prior to the starting date of the camp session or sessions chosen (a reminder will be sent to you). If full payment is not received, your camper may be dropped from the enrollment roster. Cancellations must be received in writing, by e-mail preferably or by fax, no later than 21 business days prior to the starting date of the camp session chosen in order to receive a refund of monies pre-paid. If your cancellation is received 14-21 business days prior to the starting date of the camp session chosen, you will be eligible for a refund of pre-payment less a \$25 cancellation fee. If your cancellation is received with less than 14 business days notice, there is no refund of your pre-payment. Refund requests will be processed on the last business day of each month. Camp fees will not be adjusted or pro-rated for absences.

### **\$250 Weekly Tuition (increases to \$275 after April 1<sup>st</sup>) includes:**

\* Bowling Daily - \* Up to 4 hours of skating daily! Fun, on-ice activities to include: ice painting, snowman building, basic skating skills instruction based on the Ice Skating Institute’s *We Skate* Program, open skating time - \* Arts & Crafts session each day - \* Afternoon Snack Break - \* Official Camp t-shirt - \* A weekly “field trip” to presentations in Yerba Buena Gardens - \* daily “playtime” in the wonderful Children’s Play Area (so we’re not indoors all day)!

### **Extended Care:**

We can provide extended care hours for campers before the start of camp each day from 7:30 am—8:30 am and after the end of camp each day from 5:30 pm—6:30 pm. This Extended Care is available with registration only, and is not available on a drop-in basis). A \$25 fee will be charged per camper/per week for Morning Extended Care or Afternoon Extended Care. If you choose both Morning and Afternoon Extended Care, the price is \$50 per session in addition to the tuition.

## **Be Prepared:**

Please make sure that you have athletic socks (no bare feet) for both bowling and ice skating. For skating, we also recommend warm, comfortable clothing, such as long sleeves and long pants or leggings; gloves or mittens to protect your hands are also a great idea. Please plan on an extra sweatshirt or jacket for warmth as needed, as we are an ice skating center, and can still get cool during the summer! As our daily camp schedule includes some play time outside in the Park each day, we suggest that you include a cap or hat for sun protection, and plan to send a small container of sun block for skin protection! As with any Summer Camp experience, please make sure that your camper's name is written legibly on all articles of clothing and personal belongings.

## **Ice Skating Institute We Skate Program:**

For our newest skating friends, the ISI Learn-to-Skate Program is designed to teach beginner skaters the enjoyment of ice skating. This is considered an introduction to the skills required to thoroughly enjoy the sport and create a healthy, fun and safe environment. For new skaters, your camper will be instructed in the beginner level elements, such as the proper way to fall, the proper way to get up, marching in a standing position and marching while moving through forward stroking, forward crossovers and a one-foot snowplow stop. It is our hope that they will wish to continue skating in our skating school classes to reach higher levels!

## **Field Trips:**

A parent/legal guardian signature on this form permits the camper to leave the YBIS&BC facilities on authorized field trips under the supervision of the staff. These field trips will always be within walking distance.

## **Personal Items:**

Simply, do not allow your camper to bring personal items (walkmans, I-pods, skateboards, radios, video games, cell phones etc.). YBIS&BC is NOT responsible for lost or stolen items. Alternately, you may allow the camper use of a coin operated locker on a daily basis; each time these lockers are closed and locker, it is \$.50. Please limit the camper's spending money, as there will be few needs to spend!

## **Lunches:**

We suggest that your camper bring a sack lunch. However, Mo's Grill can provide a lunch that can be ordered and paid for each morning when camper is dropped off—the cost is \$5 per day, and includes: 1/4 Hot dog with fries OR Chicken nuggets with fries OR Grilled cheese sandwich with fries OR Kid's burger with fries plus, a beverage (Pepsi OR Root beer OR Sierra Mist OR Lemonade OR Diet Pepsi OR Iced Tea OR Apple Juice). Lunches: You may send a “sack lunch” with your camper. We will also offer a daily luncheon special from Mo’s Grill for \$5; when you deliver your camper in the morning, you will be asked for your lunch request and payment, so that it can be processed for deliver at the lunch break. Afternoon snacks will be provided.

Medical Treatment: The YBIS&BC does not administer any medication. However, in the case of an emergency in which the parent cannot be contacted, emergency medical staff and the YBIS&BC may take appropriate action in the best interest of the minor child. By signature of this form, the parent/Legal Guardian does authorize YBIS&BC to arrange for transportation in case of accident or acute illness for my camper. In the event that it is impossible to receive instructions for care from said parent or legal guardian, consent is likewise given to any licensed physician called or to whom my camper is taken, for treatment as deemed necessary.

Payment and Authorized Registration

Payment Policies: By signing this form, parents/legal guardians indicate that they understand policies regarding deposit, payment, cancellation and refunds. A deposit of \$50 is required in order to register. Full balance due payment for camp is due a minimum of 21 days prior to the starting date of the camp session chosen. If full payment is not received by 14 days prior to the starting date of the camp session chosen, your camper may be dropped from the enrollment roster. Cancellations must be received in writing, by e-mail preferably or by fax, no later than 14 days prior to the starting date of the camp session chosen in order to receive a refund of monies pre-paid; if your cancellation is received 7-14 days prior to the starting date of the camp session chosen, you will be eligible for a refund of pre-payment less a \$25 cancellation fee; if your cancellation is received with less than 7 days notice, there is no refund of your pre-payment. Refund requests will be processed on the last business day of each month. Camp fees will not be adjusted or pro-rated for absences.
