Any unused credit for skate rentals can be applied toward the purchase of a new pair of skates, in addition to the 10% Skating School discount, no credit/refund if not requested at the time of skate purchase at the Pro Shop.	\$20

# Enrollment

Enrollment is open (except for the last 3 weeks of a series). If starting part way into a series, the tuition will be prorated.

Registration for a new series begins three weeks prior to the series start date for new enrollees, currently enrolled students must wait until they receive their progress report to re-enroll. Classed are filled on a first come first served basis.

To enroll, please arrive at least 45 minutes prior to the start of class. An enrollment form is available on-line on our website or in our Pro Shop

## ICE SKATES

Skaters learn more quickly when they have their own skates. If a skate rental fee is paid, then a credit for the unused portion of the rental fee is applied toward the purchase of new skates from our Pro Shop.

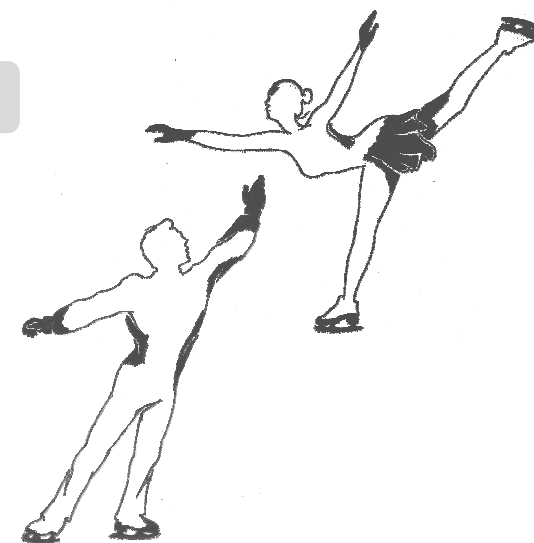
## First Day of Class

- Walk in the building 30 minutes prior to class start (take the amount of time to find parking into consideration). If you need to register, arrive at least 45 minutes early.
- Bring cotton athletic socks, that are tall enough to extend above the top of the skate, socks should not be thick winter socks.
- Bring a pair of gloves to protect hands when learning how to fall and get up safely.
- Wear comfortable pants that allow for easy movement (e.g., not tight jeans).
- Wear layers that can be removed when hot.
- Optional, bring protective gear (e.g., knee, or wrist guards) and/or a round helmet (e.g., no visor).

# Class Descriptions



## Figure Skating

### BEGINNER LEVEL CLASSES

**Little Folks & Tots** for children ages 3-5

**Beginner** for skaters age 6 and up

**Parent and Me** for toddler and parent (tuition is at the 45 minute rate, includes parent and child)

### FOUNDATIONAL CLASSES

*Maneuvers may include:*

**Pre-Alpha**—swizzles and one-foot glides

**Alpha**—forward stroking and crossovers

**Beta**—backward stroking and crossovers

**Gamma**—outside three turns and mohawks

**Delta**—inside three turns and edges

### FREESTYLE

Footwork, jumps and spins

### SYNCHRONIZED

Team skating in formations, (prerequisite for Intro to Sync—passed all beta elements, Adult Synchronized—pass all gamma requirements and working on Delta skills or above)

## Name Tags

Your name tag is your ticket to your class. You must bring it each week. When you arrive, please present your name tag at the front window to check-in. The cashier will validate your card so that you can be admitted to your class. You must wear your name tag while taking your class. If you are doing a make-up, please present your name tag and inform the cashier that you are doing a make-up. The first time you forget your name tag, you will be given a temporary name tag for one lesson. If you forget your name tag a second time, you will have to purchase a new one to be admitted into class.

## Details

### CLASS LEVELS & TESTING

Students new to our program are evaluated and placed in the appropriate class. Students may be promoted to a more advanced class with the approval of the Skating Directors, additional pro rated tuition may apply. Testing is done at the second/third week from the end of the series. Test will not be given on the last day of class.

### MAKE-UP CLASSES

Make up classes can be done before or after an absence. *All make ups must be completed by the end of the series.* Adults may take any non-adult class on a regular basis or as a make-up class.

### GUEST PASSES & PUBLIC SESSIONS

Learning to skate takes practice. We encourage our students to practice before or after their class and come to Public Sessions regularly.

Students are given guest passes when they enroll. Passes cannot be replaced if lost, must be presented at the time of entry, and expire at the end of the series. Guest passes may be used either by student or friend/family member during any Public Session (may not be used for practice ice).

Students also have one free admission to a Public Session immediately before or after their class, same day only. Otherwise, students can skate at a discounted rate by requesting the "Skating School Rate" at the time of admission only.
