Fee / Discounts

Guest Passes— Number of Guest Passes that are issued with enrollment in a full series, which expire at the end of the series and cannot be replaced if lost or stolen; 1 guest pass for Pro Rated classes. 2

ISI Registration— Required annual membership fee good through August 2012 \$20

Skate Rental— During class and one public session immediately before or after class (same day), rate of \$2 per class. For Hockey Tots 1 & 2, Skate Rental Fee is waived. Any unused credit for skate rentals can be applied toward the purchase of a new pair of skates, in addition to the 10% Skating School discount. \$20

Public Skating— When skating at a public session, request your "Skating School" admission price at the time of admission only, no refunds, (does not include skate rental). Students skate for free at one (1) public session immediately before or after their class (same day). \$6

Family Discount★ Savings for each additional family member (immediate family, or members of a family permanently residing in the same physical address (discount does not apply to first family member, Second Class/es) when registering at the same time. -\$10

Early Re Enrollment Discount★ Savings for current students when re-enrolling before the last day of a series (one per student, discount does not apply to Second Class/es) -\$10

Second Class Discount★ Savings off tuition if you take a second class during a series, discount taken off lower tuition amount (no additional discounts applicable to the second class/es), one guest pass for second class if registering for a full series. 50%

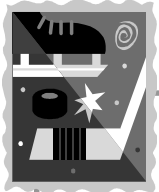

TODDLER CLASSES

Hockey Tots— children age 3 to 6

FOUNDATIONAL LEVEL CLASSES

Beginner Hockey— children 7 and up (or 3-6 who have successfully completed Hockey Tots) basic forward skating and stopping

Pond Hockey— advanced forward skating and stopping, intro to stick handling

INFORMAL/INSTRUCTIONAL HOCKEY

Mini Mites— backward skating and crossovers, passing, shooting

Sabercats In-House Instructional League— For graduates of Mini Mites. Our ISI based In-House program reinforces basic skating and stick skills. Team practices and refereed cross-ice games introduce tactics and systems.

SABERCATS TRAVEL TEAMS

Our travel teams participate in the competitive, USA Hockey-sanctioned Northern California Junior Hockey Association (NORCAL). Teams are based on current USA Hockey age groupings, practice twice a week, and play 1-2 games per weekend during the regular season. Tryouts typically take place in August and the regular season ends in Mid-March. High school team practices and has exhibition games at Yerba Buena Ice Skating Center, but plays games in San Jose.

Details

INSTRUCTION

Our Ice Skating Institute (ISI) and USA Hockey based instruction teaches students in basic hockey skating skills so that they can move on to become proficient hockey players. We emphasize team work, sportsmanship and fun.

MAKE-UP CLASSES

Make up classes can be done before or after an absence. *All make ups must be completed by the end of the series*

GUEST PASSES & PUBLIC SESSIONS

Learning to skate takes practice. We encourage our students to practice before or after their class and come to Public Sessions regularly.

Students are given guest passes when they enroll. Passes cannot be replaced if lost, must be presented at the time of entry, and expire at the end of the series. Guest passes may be used either by student or friend/family member during any Public Session (may not be used for practice ice).

Students also have one admission to a Public Session immediately before or after their class, same day only. Otherwise, students can skate at a discounted rate by requesting the “Skating School Rate” at the time of admission only.

Enrollment

Enrollment is open (except for the last 3 weeks of a series). If starting part way into a series, the tuition will be prorated.

Registration for a new series begins three weeks prior to the series start date for new enrollees, currently enrolled students must wait until they receive their report card to re-enroll. Classes are filled on a first come first served basis.

To enroll, please arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the start of class (45 minutes during the first 2 weeks of a new series). An enrollment form is available on-line on our website or in our Pro Shop
